Carroll County Mid-Maryland Workforce Investment Board Seeking Members for Vacancies

October 31, 2008 – The Carroll County Board of Commissioners are accepting applications to fill upcoming vacancies for the Mid-Maryland Workforce Investment Board (Mid-MD WIB). The term for all vacancies will begin immediately and are for three years.
